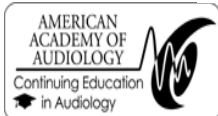
Department of State: Division of Licensing Announcement

Effective immediately, all registered Hearing Aid Dispensers whose license is to expire on or after July 1, 2009 are required to complete two hours of infection control and one hour of New York State and Federal Law, regulations and professional conduct. This is in addition to the already mandated 20 hours of continuing education as approved by New York State Department of State.

Also affected by the new regulation are Hearing Aid Dispensers also licensed as Audiologists through the Department of Education. Such licensees must complete four hours of hearing aid dispenser related topics in which at least two hours must include the topic of infection control and at least one hour must include New York State and Federal law, regulations and professional conduct.
